Ann's Creative Corner Project #529: Spring Flowers!

- Cut out some green stems and leaves from some scrap paper.
- Children can use a glue stick to form the basis for the flowers by glueing them onto another piece of Springtime Construction paper.
- Add the various shapes of petals to form the flowers at the top.
- A cupcake paper works nicely for Daffodils as you may glue the cupcake paper into the centre of your stems to form your flower shapes.
- Add details with felt markers and crayons.
- Use a QTip for light painting.
- Add some sprinkles of sparkles to make it pretty and reflective. This can be used as the "Sun" shining on your flowers!
- Think of other ways such as your hand print could also be a stem
- Try painting your fingertips and adding the fingerprint to the top of your stems.
- Add details to your fingerprint flowers with a felt marker when the paint is dry!
