Project #532: Easter Baskets!

- Create a basket shape.
- Children may draw a weaved look into the basket.
- Also slits may be cut into the basket to create a weaving paper through the slits effect (Older children)
- For toddlers you may like to pre-draw a weaved look onto the basket and they may draw or colour onto this.
- Attach some egg shapes to the basket. These can be on the top looking as though they are in the basket or anywhere the children choose if fine too.
- Children often decorate the entire basket in any way they like.
- Younger children and Toddler may only put a few eggs onto the basket which is fine too.
- Stickers are also an option if children like this. Good for fine motor control but less creative.
- Try some small bingo daubers or QTip painting.

(This can be done with a real basket and some plastic eggs)
