Ann's Creative Corner Project #523: Sand Art!

- Gather some sand from the beach or buy some in store.
- On a Piece of cardboard paper or in a plastic reusable container, place some liquid non toxic white glue in this.
- Children may use a stir stick or popsicle stick to swirl a design they like with the glue and the stick.
- When you are happy with your swirls, sprinkle some sand onto the glue.
- Try using various colours of sand if you buy some.
- The natural sand will also come in various shades of greys and browns.
- Add more texture to your design with small pebbles and colourful tissue paper.
- If you make this in a plastic recycle container, you may be able to pull it off the container as a one piece creation. Try placing it in a window or on a window sill.
- What about sparkles too!

Activity: Go to the beach and collect sand and small items such as pebbles and shells. Make a sandcastle!
