Project #524: Wood Art!

- Using natural sticks, shape wood pieces or popsicle sticks, start creating!
- These can be glued onto a piece of cardboard, a recycle type tray, a foil pan or other boxes and various trays.
- Spread non toxic white glue onto the surface of your choice.
- Lay your wood pieces on in any way you like.
- If you choose stackable type wood such as popsicle sticks, you may like to create a Structure such as making a house or a fence with your flat sticks.
- Try making logs in the water or a Log Boon!
- The flat sticks can be raised as high as you like by adding more glue and sticks to increase the height.
- If you have some sand or other textured materials that you like, try adding some details with them by glueing some more.
- Sprinkle your creation with sparkles if you like.
- Try some confetti or other materials.
- Please do not waste foods such as pasta and rice as they are wasteful and edible items.
- Sparkles could be used, drops of paint or food colouring....

Activity: Go for a walk to gather your items for this project. Go to the store to buy some colourful sticks and wooden shapes.
