Project #528: Spring Trees!

- Use scraps of brown construction paper to make tree trunks and branches.
- Glue these onto a piece of paper of any kind. Blue or Green would be nice for the Spring!
- Also a hand print could be used for your tree shape by tracing your hand or making a handprint by painting your hand.
- When you are done with your tree shape in the way you like, start to add the Blossoms for your spring tree.
- Blossoms are nice with pink or white tissue paper made with tiny crumples of the tissue paper.
- Glue them on by first placing the glue stick onto the tree and then sticking the tissue paper onto the glue.
- Try using a QTip to make blossoms if you like. Small dots of pink or white paint would make nice blossoms.

Activity: Go for a walk and view the Spring Trees! Take photos! Gather petals that may have fallen to the ground!
