Project #531: Easter Crafts!

- Cut out egg shapes and bunny shapes
- Using various pieces of colourful scrap paper, make some shapes such as circles, triangles, squares and rectangles. Or just be creative and use any shape. Paper may also be torn into shapes. Try some zig zag scissors as well
- Some children may be able to help with scissor cutting and this is a great experience for those who are learning to cut. These are various shapes so not perfect!
- With a glue stick, add your shapes to the egg shapes.
- Add some stickers if you like.
- Add some sparkles such as liquid type or shaker kind.
- For the Bunny, you could add some cotton balls (Please stretch the cotton so it is wider and not too wasteful)
- Try adding some wool string to the bunny too is an option.
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Felt Story: "Easter Bunny is Looking For Fun!"

(children bring paper or felt eggs to the speaker)

Easter Bunny is looking for fun,

Easter Bunny is looking around for an egg the colour of Brown!

Easter Bunny is looking for an egg the colour of Yellow. (That will make him a happy fellow.

Green should be seen. Who has the egg that is green.

Repeat the story until all eggs have been found and place them on the felt board.

Improvise the wording as you may using rhyming words to match the colours of the eggs!
