Project #533: Bird Projects!

- Provide a cardboard tracer of a bird shape you may like. These can be simple or complex depending on the age or stage of the children.
- Some children may be able to trace this and some may not.
- For the younger children and Toddlers, Adults or older children may help with tracing or have pre cut bird shapes.
- When you have your bird shapes, glue them onto another piece of paper if you like.
- Add some drawing to your bird for some details.
- Add some sticker eyes or draw the eyes.
- Attach some feathers with some liquid non toxic white glue.
- Please put glue onto the bird shape and then add the feathers as the glue will be very sticky to try to put it directly on the feathers. It is okay to teach the children "How to Use the glue efficiently"

Activity: Bird Watching!

Go for a walk in various areas to look for birds. Ducks, Geese and Herons are at the Riverfront. Also you will see Seagulls, Pigeons, Crows and other birds there too. LISTEN for the chirping and cawing of the birds. Try to make some bird sounds. Listen to music with some bird sounds. Try to make some bird sounds with whistles and instruments!
