### Project #534: Nests!

- Create a nest shape from a print or draw your own style!
- Add details to the nest with some felt marker, crayons or pencil crayons.
- Add some details with some scrap paper, tissue paper for texture or some pieces of straw and grass which birds would naturally build their nests with.
- Some soil is also an idea as birds use the mud based soil to create the nest.
- Try adding some natural dried grass to the nest.
- Place your nest onto a piece of construction paper and then add scenery details or birds.
- Add some egg shapes to the nest.
- Try some stickers for the younger children.
- Making a duck pond within your creation is another idea

**Activity:** Walk and look for the nests in the trees. Note how the birds will fly back and forth to the nest building it and also feeding the baby birds. Check out the marshlands in the river area and you may see the baby ducks and geese come out.
