Project #536: Bean Growing!

- Place bean seeds into wet paper towels and keep moistened daily
- When beans start to sprout in the wet paper towels, observe them until they have a root. This may take a few days up to a week depending on the warmth and moisture of the potted seeds.
- In small compostable planting containers, place some soil in to the pot about 3/4 full.
- Place sprouted bean seed onto the soil gently so as not to break the root or sprout.
- Cover this lightly with more soil.
- Dampen this with lightly sprayed water on top.
- Each day, be sure to spray more water onto this to keep it moist.
- Place your pot into a warm sunny window but not too hot.
- When the bean starts to grow leaves, monitor the soil and roots to be sure it is growing strongly.
- When this becomes root bound (you will seed the roots at the bottom through the biodegradable pot) Transfer the plant into a larger pot.
- Place it into your garden or on a patio.
- This can also be done in clear plastic cups so you may see the roots growing. This is interesting for the children.
