Project #537: Finger Print Flowers!

- Use various colours of construction paper.
- Dip your finger
- onto a pad of paint. This can be made from paper towels soaked lightly in non toxic washable paint.
- Use various colours for your flower top.
- Let this dry and then add some details to the flower top use thin felt markers or QTip dipped into paint.
- Add some leaves with the QTip painting.
- Or add some construction paper leaves by glueing them onto the flower.
- Try adding some sparkles if you like. This can be done onto the wet paint or glue.
- Liquid sparkles may also be used.
- Try various shapes of flowers.
- Each flower may have a single fingerprint or many fingerprints attached. Try a whole hand print flower!
- Be creative! There is no limit and no rules!

Activity: Visit a Garden centre to view the flowers. Buy some bedding plants and pot them into bigger pots or into your garden!
