- Make a handprint from painting your child's hand with non-toxic paint and making a print onto paper.
- This will be the tree trunk and the branches.
- Try drawing or taking a print of a bare tree.
- Add some white or pink tissue paper to this with tiny pieces of crumpled tissue to form the blossoms on the Branches.
- Some blossoms may also be falling to the ground and on the ground.
- Colour the tree with more details if you like. Pencil crayons would be nice for this.
- Make a scene around the tree.
- Children all vary so they may do a little or alot. It is their creation so let them be free to choose what they do.
- Fingerprint blossoms would also be nice for this project!
- Try glue on some real dried blossoms.
- Flatten some blossoms into newspaper and let them dry. Place books on top of the newspaper for a day or two to flatten them
