Anns Creative Corner Project #594: MIXING Colours!

- Colours are fun to mix.
- Try blending paint in swirls to see what colours you can create.
- Use various scraps of paper to create a colourful collage of shapes.
- Mlx some food colouring in water and blend two colours at a time to see what you achieve
- Do some paint stamping by placing various colours of paint on a paper towel in a flat recycle container.
- Children can then use various tools to make shapes and blend colours.
- Some ideas could be items such as some plastic kitchen utensils.
- Also try some plastic cups, plastic plates and plastic bowls to see the shapes and the blending of the circle shapes.
- Some children will just enjoy painting and swirling.
- This is a very free project so enjoy!
- Add some sparkles for fun and see the various colours than sparkles can make.
- Sparkle glue of various colours is also nice.

Activity: For Science:

Fill 6 clear plastic or glass jars with water.

Add the 3 primary colours red, yellow and blue (one colour in each jar)

After try blue in yellow so you make green

Then try red in yellow so you make orange.

Then try blue in red so you make purple.

These are the secondary colours.
