Project #597: Vehicles!

- Create various shapes of vehicles and cut the shapes out.
- Cut additional shapes from your scraps of paper for the doors, windows, exhaust pipes etc.
- Use some shiny foil or cellophane for trims such as the lights, and accents to your vehicle.
- Ideas of vehicles could be buses, cars, trucks, bicycles, scooters, skate boards, Ebikes etc.
- When you have all the pieces ready, children may glue them onto a piece of paper or glue larger ones without a background paper.
 Fire Trucks make a great larger individual vehicle.
- If you choose, you may like to make a scene onto your paper around your vehicle/s.
- On a large piece of poster board or on the sidewalk, make a road/s with some chaulk. Be sure this is in a safe place with NO vehicle traffic or pedestrian, or bicycle path!
- People may also be drawn into the project.
- Try some stickers of people and animals.

<u>Activity</u>: Transportation adventure! Let's see how we travel with the bus, sky train, car, bikes etc. Talk about safety of travel and the rules of the road, sidewalks, bike paths and the safety traffic lights, and pedestrian signs. Remind children that all traffic lights and pedestrian signals apply to bikes as well. <u>This includes all STOP SIGNS!</u>
