### Project #637: Christmas/Holiday Wreaths!

- Cut out the center of a paper plate so that you are left with a “Ring”
- Wrap the ring in various paper, string or ribbons to cover it.
- Add some details to this covered ring such as stickers, drawings, sparkles etc.
- Add some natural fibers like pieces of evergreen tree branches. Cedar thin branches work well with this as they are more flexible and do not dry out as fast or loose the pine or evergreen “needles”
- Make a handle for the top with more ribbon or pipe cleaner. Attach after punching two holes in the top with a hole puncher.
- You may also like to add some small pine cones to this creation using a hot glue gun or non-toxic liquid glue. **Hot Glue guns can burn so not intended for younger Children and Toddlers**
- Bingo dabbers or Qtip painting may also be done on your plain “Ring”
- Before the paint is dry, sprinkle some sparkles onto your creation!
- Add a ribbon on streamers onto the bottom of your Wreath as well if you like

#### Song: “Deck the Halls”

**Activity:** Place your creation onto the doorway. If you make very small circles, they may be hung from door knobs.
