Ann's Creative Corner Project #623: Remembrance Day Headbands!

- Headbands can be made by cutting strips of construction paper and measured to the child's head
- First lay the strip of Black construction paper flat.
- Glue on some small red poppy shapes.
- Add details such as the black centre circle.
- A small green round dot or sticker can be placed in the centre of the black circle as well.
- Children may like to add details to the poppies with felt markers or crayons. These details may be lines, dots or other shapes the children choose to make.
- Make poppy Headbands from cloth strips.
- Make poppy headbands by attaching red poppy shapes to your own hairband or headband.

Activity: Circle Time wearing your poppy headbands.
