Ann's Creative Corner Project #645: Ice Play!

- Freeze various shapes and sizes of ice cubes.
- Various shapes can be made from ice cube trays, recycle shapes from plastic inserts from packaging can be used as well
- Try freezing some water with colours, sparkle or lightweight small pieces of tissue paper.
- When it is frozen, pop the ice cubes out and place in a large bowl.
- Children can have fun stirring the ice and have it move around slowly melting.
- Try adding some salt to help it melt. Coarse salt or table salt are both suitable for this.
- While it melts, continue stirring and blending the various shapes together.
- Observe the changes; some ice may stick to other pieces.
- Colours, sparkles and tissue paper will blend.
- Try pouring some warm or hot water onto this.
- When done playing with this, you may like to freeze it again and see the new shape!

Activities: Go visit an ice rink. Buy some ice from a vending machine or store. Pour ice into a cup and place it near some heat or outdoors in the sun.
