Project #665: Poster Paints!

(by Kids Care Preschool)

- Provide the children with some dry poster paints.
- Provide a container of water and some paint brushes
- Show the children how to dip the paint brush into the water and then swirl the wet paint brush onto the paint cake.
- Explain the more they swirl, the more colour they will get.
- Also mention that too much water will lead to less colour as well as the paper will get too wet and rip.
- Provide plain paper or shaped paper.
- Try various types of paper such as coffee filters, printing paper, wall paper, construction paper, poster boards etc.
- Wall paper or poster boards are quite strong for this activity.
- Do a group painting if you like.
- Adding other details such as sparkles on the wet paint would enhance the creation.
- Try sprinkling confetti on the wet paint.

Activity: Mixing Colours!

In plastic see through containers or glasses, try mixing food colouring.

- Place water in the containers.
- Add a drop of a primary colour, Add another and see what happens!
