Ann's Creative Corner Project #669: Gadget Painting!

- On a washable tray, place a paper towel.
- Pour some nontoxic liquid paint onto the paper towel
- Make various trays of various colours.
- Provide children various Kitchen gadgets such as Masher, ladles, spoons, or any other non sharp plastic kitchen gadgets you may use for baking/cooking.
- Provide the children with various colours of paper; preferably
 Construction paper as it is quite absorbent.
- Children may dip the gadget into the paint and then press it onto their paper.
- Encourage the children to explore the various colours and gadgets to continue to print onto their paper/s.
- Try doing this as a group project with a piece of cardboard or a poster board.
- If you like, before the paint is dry add other details like sparkles, tissue paper, powder etc.
- Try adding sprinkles of other powdered paint!

Activity: Marching Mats!

Use some floor mats of various colours and sizes and shapes. Play some music while the children march or walk across the mats. When the music stops, the children stop. Ask "What Colour are you on?"
