## Ann's Creative Corner Project #670: St Patrick's Day!

- Cut out some 3 leaf clover shapes. (Green)
- Cut out some 4 leaf clover shapes. (Green)
- Snip some green tissue paper into small thin pieces.
- Supply the children with glue sticks, the clover/s, felt markers and tissue paper pieces.
- Children may spread the glue over the clover shape.
- Next the children may like to scrunch the tissue to glue it on or they may like to lay it flat and glue it on.
- Some children like to have a variety of styles of tissue paper.
- Offer a sticker or two after they have finished the glueing.
- Sparkles may also be added to this by sprinkling some on at the end of the project.

## **Awareness and Activity**:

Talk about the difference between the 3 leaf and the 4 leaf clover. The four leaf clover is said to be the Lucky One!

Go outdoors to a field where you may find clover. Pick a few and take them home or to School for viewing and sorting. What type did you find!
