Project #674: Daffodils!

(by Kids Care Preschool)

- Cut some green paper stems and leaves or a daffodil full stem with leaves out of white paper.
- Paint the leaves and stems Green if you use the white shape.
- Paint the flower part Yellow.
- If you use green pieces, glue them together or glue onto another piece of paper.
- When you are done painting and gluing the stem and flower add a cup cake paper cup to the center of the daffodil flower. This can be done if you place glue on the back of the cupcake cup.
- It may also stick to the dried painted surface if you wait for the paint to dry and place the glue onto the paper daffodil shape. (this may be easier for younger children and Toddlers)

Things to see and Smell!

- Fresh Daffodils!
- Have a bouquet of Daffodils in some water!
- Walk and find the Daffodils!
- Visit a Greenhouse to find some daffodil bulbs to plant!
