Ann's Creative Corner Project #680: Spring Lambs!

- Provide a Lamb shape and a sheep shape
- Supplies: Glue Stick, cotton balls and felt makers, crayons, pencil crayons, sticker eyes, googly eyes etc.
- Children may draw in some detail on their lamb and/or sheep with the pens and crayons.
- Add some glue all over the lamb and sheep.
- Then pull the cotton balls apart to Stretch the cotton as this makes a nice fluffy lighter look for your project. This also saves on waste or materials.
- When your Lamb/Sheep are done you may want to make them into a puppet by attaching a wooden stick to the bottom of them.
- Another idea is to place them onto another piece of paper to create a Scenic picture with other details such as the fields, trees, clouds, sun, rain etc.
