Ann's Creative Corner Project #682: Easter Bunnies!

- Create a Bunny Shape out of construction paper. Most bunnies are brown, black or white but be creative and make various colours if you like.
- Supply Stretched cotton puffs (this extends it for less waste)
- Glue stick is best for this as it has a nice thin layer for cotton to stick on the paper.
- Add details to the face such as eyes, nose and a mouth.
- Add details to the inner ear and feet may have lines for toes.
- Add a carrot shape to the bunny as he may be eating it!
- Try to add bits of colour here and there to add some details.
- One full cotton ball could be the tail.
- Paint your bunny!
- If you like, place your bunny or bunnies onto another piece of paper or postboard to create a scene for you bunnies. This could be a nice group project for family and friends!

Activity: Visit a pet store or farm with bunnies! Feel how soft they are. Feed them lettuce and carrots if allowed. Watch them hop and socialize with each other.
