Project #684: Easter Chicks!

- Attach a chick shape to a popsicle stick.
- Supply some pom, pom, feathers, sticker eyes and felt markers for children to decorate the chick
- Children may like to use the sticker eyes, googly eyes and draw eyes on their chick.
- Next glue on feathers and pom, poms if they like.
- Supply some yellow tissue paper as this is another idea to scrunch it up and glue it onto the chick shape this gives it some texture.
- Try gluing an egg shape onto the stick first and then the chick shape as it is hatching from the egg.
- Add some sparkles if you like.
- Qtip painting may be nice.

Activity: Puppet Show!

Children may like to have a puppet show and make up their own story of their Easter Chick.

Farm Visit: Go to a local farm and see the eggs and chicks that are hatching!
