Project #689: Flowers and Petals!

- Provide children with a circle for the center of the flower. Yellow, Orange and Red are most common but any colour will be creative!
- Cut out some flower petal shapes.
- Cut out some smaller circles which would look nice with a zig zag edge or wavy lines.
- Supply some textured paper such as tissue paper.
- Children may glue the petals onto the circle.
- You may like to secure the petals in place by gluing another circle on top of the first circle to ensure they do not come off.
- Add the smaller circle into the center.
- Children may like to draw details on their flower/s.
- Children may like to add some texture to their flower/s with the tissue paper.
- Maybe add sparkles if you like.
- Use these flowers as decorations for the walls or windows.
- Add some green leaves and stems if you like.

Activity: Care of Flowers!

Go to a greenhouse or garden center to view the flowers such as the seedlings and the larger potted flowering plants. Take a look at the cut flowers as well. Ask the Staff to show you how to care for flowers.
