Ann's Creative Corner Project #692: Caterpillars!

- Cut some circles of various colours
- Cut some short strips on paper for the legs.
- Glue circles together in a long or short line.
- Add some feelers or antennae to the head of your caterpillar
- Add some eyes by drawing them or using sticker eyes.
- Glue many legs onto all of the circles.
- Add some snippets of light shavings of wool or yard to give the caterpillar a fuzzy look.
- If you like you may glue this onto a paper and add a branch onto the paper for the caterpillar to be placed on as they are "Crawling on the Branch.
- Count how many circles you used for your caterpillar.
- Add more details to your paper such as scenery and other springtime trees, sun and clouds.

Story: "The Very Hungry Caterpillar"

This may be a felt story as well. Children may hold a piece of the story and add it to the felt board when their piece is called. Counting is great in this story as it is a fun way to practice counting. Colours are also a great part to practice in the story.
