Project #693: Butterflies!

- Cut some strips of paper for the body of the butterfly.
- Cut two or four wing shapes.
- Cut some thin antennae shapes.
- Glue the wings onto the body.
- Glue a very small circle onto the body for the head.
- Glue the antenna onto the top of the head.
- Add detail such as the eye by just making a dot or small circle.
- If the butterfly is large enough, you may like googly eyes or stickers.
- Add some dots or shapes to the butterflies wings.
- Add some tissue paper to the wings. This would look nice to layer to give the butterfly more colours.
- Try using some colourful cellophane paper onto the wings.
- Use pom poms too if you like.

Action Song: “Fly away Little Butterfly”

Fly away little butterfly way up to the sky (Child pretends to fly and chooses another friend.)
