Ann's Creative Corner Project #695: Mother's Day Flower Pots!

- Prepare for the project by purchasing some seedling type small flowers such as marigolds, petunias, carnations or other small potted flowers.
- You may have the children re-pot these into a slightly larger pot for the experience of gardening and planting
- When you have your flowers ready in the selected pot it is time to cover the pot with some nice paper.
- The paper could be foil, or wrapping paper which can be wrapped around the pot and taped on.
- Add a ribbon and a bow onto the pot after the paper.
- Another idea is to use a round coffee filter to tie around the pot.
- Children could draw with felt marker onto the coffee filter before placing it around the pot!
- Bingo dabbers on the coffee filters also will look nice. When the coffee filter is dry. Place it around the flower pot.

<u>Activity</u>: Let's make handprints for Mother's Day too. Paint your child's palm. Make a print onto some pretty paper.
