Project #697: Fresh Flowers!

- Gather some fresh flowers.
- Press them between some books or magazines.
- Let them dry for a few days.
- Place the dried flowers between some waxed paper and cover with newspaper layer.
- Place a thin cotton cloth over this.
- Iron with a medium setting on the iron so that the waxed paper sticks together to encase the flower petals and stems.
- When cool you may like to trim the paper to form the shape of the flowers arrangement as you like
- Adding a border with some coloured masking tape will secure the edges better and look nice as well
- You may also like to do some variations to this project by adding small bits of cotton, seeds, sparkles or anything fairly flat before pressing them in place.

Activity: Gathering Flowers and Seeds!

Go for a nature walk to collect the items you wish to use for the project. Talk about the items such as colours, shapes, texture, scent etc.
