Project #698: Making "Perfume"!

- Gather some fresh flowers that are quite scented. Wild Roses and Carnations may be good for this project.
- Pull the flower petals off.
- Place the flower petals in a glass see through jar.
- Add some warm water.
- Close the lid.
- Wait a few days as the water and petals settle together.
- Open the jar and see how the scent smells.
- If it does not have any scent or if it is faint, add some more flower petals and close again for a few days.
- When you are happy with the scent, strain the flower petals and the liquid to create your own "Perfume"!
- If your flower petals do not work, find a different type of flower.....

Activity: Let the flower petals dry out and then use them for Art Work!

Lay flower petals on some absorbent paper towels until dry. You may want to use these for gluing onto paper for art.
