Ann's Creative Corner Project #699: Paper Plate Flowers!

- Use various sizes and colours of paper plates
- Thin paper plates may work the best for this project.
- Attach them together in a flower shape using glue, staples or tape to secure the shape in place.
- Toddlers and Preschool children may like smaller thinner plates as this will be easier for their small hands and capabilities.
- Place a centerpiece such as a round circle glued onto the plate/s.
- Use some glue, glitter, sprinkles, seeds (Dandelion) to decorate your flower shapes.
- Tissue paper scrunched up would also looks nice.
- Try using Bingo Dabbers!
- Spray the "Flower/s" with some light scented perfume.
- Add some scented powder to the flower by using a glue stick and then sprinkle talcum powder on your creations!

Activity:

Purchase the plates together with your children so they may choose and be part of the process of this creation. Test and see which perfumes or colognes you may like to use. Use a testing paper to spray the scent onto it.
