Project #700: Sunglasses!

- Create the shape of a sun from yellow construction paper.
- Create the shape of sunglasses of various colours and styles with the dark shade part in the center.
- Also you may like to fill in the "shade part" with some cellophane shiny see through paper for a different style. The center of the Glasses Shape could be cut out and replaced with tinted cellophane paper of darker colours and other various colours.
- The "Sunglasses" could be placed on top of the sun by gluing them on if you like.
- If you find a form in an art store of the glasses, they may have the center opening to fill in with some tinted plastic or cellophane paper.

Activity:

Test out your "Sunglasses" by wearing them if they are the type to place on your ears. Go for a walk and try them. Try your regular store bought sunglasses to see the difference in them. Talk about sun safety for the eyes. UV rays and protecting the eyes!

Try using some cellophane shade paper on a pair of Goggles!
