Project #701: Kites!

- Cut the Diagonal Corners of construction paper to resemble a Kite Shape. The top should have a shorter "V", the bottom a longer "V"
- Attached some tape to each point.
- Use a hole punch to punch a hole in each point.
- Tie a loop string in the top as this will be the "Handle" of the kite for the children. Please make it short as the children can hold this easily. Also this should be short for the safety of the children and pets. Long strings are a choking hazard.
- Draw two lines in center of the triangle so they cross each other to imitate the sticks that are in store bought kites.
- Children may decorate the kite with felt markers, crayons, stickers, glitter, stamps etc.
- Add some streamers to the bottom of the kite by threading them through the punched hole or gluing them on to the bottom.

Activity: Have Fun With Your Kite!

Walk with it, run with it. Have a kite parade! Walk with it in the air with bubbles!

Try a store bought kite as well!
