Project #702: Balloon Art!

- Cut the shape of Balloon out of various colours.
- Attach strings to the bottom for its tails.
- Attach one string to the top as a "Handle" Make it small and short so it is not a choking item. Secure the ends attached to the bottom and the top with scotch tape. Sparkles would be nice!
- Children may decorate this as they like.
- Provide Bingo dabbers or paint with very thin paint brushes.
- Compare this with a regular balloon but also be aware of balloon safety.
- Balloons can be a choking hazard as if they pop as the small pieces of the rubber can be a choking hazard.
- Do not put the rubber in your mouth, discard it immediately!
- With your paper balloon, you may like to hang it from a door knob.
- Or hang many various colours or designs.

Activity:

Balloon run. Run or walk with your balloons. Try them in the wind!
Compare colours and designs. Count them with your friends!
