Ann's Creative Corner Project #707: Gadget and Utensil Painting & Prints!

- Gather some kitchen utensils for making prints with paint.
- These utensils could be ladles, mashers, flat egg lifters, sifters, measuring spoons that are not sharp.
- Other items could be plastic utensils such as plastic cutlery with non sharp edges.
- Place paper towels in various plastic reusable trays.
- Add some paint with just enough to cover the paper towel.
- Provide constitution paper or a poster board if you have a group of children. This is a nice group project.
- All children or the child may press the utensil onto the paint in the tray and proceed to make prints by pressing the paint utensil onto the paper.
- When you are done with the printing, try adding more detail.
- Sprinkle sparkles before it is dry.
- Add details with Felt markers or crayons after it is dry.

Activity: Do a cooking Project with various kitchen utensils with your children. Make some playdough using measuring cups and utensils. Children may help with measuring and stirring for playdough or baking or other cooking projects!
