Project #708: 3D Constuction Paper Houses!

(Kids Care Preschool Project)

- Fold various sizes of construction paper to form corners and edges.
- Turn some edges to the triangle shape as well.
- Add the roof type shingle design.
- Add doors, windows and people as you like.
- Colour these in any way you think is good for your creation/s
- Place these houses onto a surface such as a poster board or piece of cardboard and tape them down in place.
- Add some scenery by drawing onto the surface of the poster board or cardboard.
- Tissue paper may look nice if scrunched up to seem like flowers and bushes.
- Add some 3D trees which could be made from Paper Towel rolls cut in half. Flute the edge so it may be taped or glued onto the cardboard or poster board surface. Add a construction paper top! (half circle bent to form a cone)
