Project #711: Coupons & Foot Prints for Dad!

- Create a coupon booklet for things that you may like to do for your Dad.
- Add some details to your booklet by colouring it in or creating some other small drawing within the coupon pages or on separate pages
- Staple them together and use as Dad sees fit.
- Footprints can be made by painting the child's feet and gently placing the foot on some paper. Be sure the child is balanced as this can be slippery. Do not paint a foot if the child does not like this. In this case, perhaps they would like the foot to be traced.
- Both of these can be fun as "Tickling your Feet" with the paint or the tracing.....
- On the Foot print page, you may find a special saying such as on the sample page below.
- There would be many pages like this online or in stores that you may purchase or print.

Activity: Walk and Talk!

Children may have a one to one walk and talk with Daddy. Compare the foot sizes from child to adult. Trace or paint DADDY'S FOOT too!

Book: Guess how much I Love You" About a father rabbit and a baby rabbit that copies many actions until the baby rabbit falls asleep.
