Project #712: Sunshine!

- Cut out round circles from yellow or gold construction paper.
- Cut long thin strips of paper from the remainder of the yellow or gold paper. (this is less waste and great use of all the paper)
- Children may glue the long strips of paper onto the circle in the form of sunshine rays.
- Add a face to your sunshine!
- Add some sparkles to this as well to make it glow like a sunshine!
- These could be liquid non toxic sparkles or use a glue stick and some shaker sparkles.
- If the children are interested you may like to use a variety of neutral coloured sparkles such as gold, silver and bronze sparkles!
- For the sunshine face, children can draw their own or some children may like to use precut shapes to glue onto the circle and then draw in the details.
- Stickers or googly eyes may also be used but are less creative.

Please look it up on UTube or other media to find the version you wish. Keep the words simple for the younger children or Toddlers. A simple song with one or two verses is suitable for the younger ones.
