- Prepare red maple leaf shapes for the center of your flag.
- Use the remaining red paper for the two strips of red for the outer edge of your flag.
- Glue the flag pieces onto a white piece of plain paper.
- Add a straw to the back of your flag shape.
- Add some scrunched small bits of red tissue paper by gluing them on with a glue stick.
- Try making many flags and attach them with a string to a long stick.
- Hang this mobile from a window or a door knob.
- Add some stickers to your own flag creation!
- On the back of your flag, add some printing of what makes you happy about Canada!
