Project #718: Bird Art!

- Provide children with a bird shape cut from construction paper or various colours.
- Use the left over construction paper to cut out various sizes of "Bird Feather Shapes"
- Children may glue the shapes on as feathers for the bird.
- You may also provide some feathers from a craft or dollar store to glue onto the bird shape.
- Provide some felt markers or crayons or pencils to create details such as eyes and details to the "feather look".
- Try some sticker eyes or googly eyes if you like. Please know that Googly eyes are not recommended for children under 3 years old as they can be a choking hazard.
- Try using some QTip painting on your bird too. This can make a nice detailing on your "Feathers"

Activity: Bird Watching

Go for a walk and see how many birds you may find. Listen and look for the birds' nests and possibly baby birds tweeting. Talk about the various colours of birds and what they may eat. Have a bird feeder with seeds for the local birds. Baby birds will only eat what the parents bring them!
