Project #722: Caterpillar Art!

- Cut numerous circles out of various colours of paper.
- Cut some thin strips of paper for the legs of the caterpillar.
- Children may glue as many circles together as they like to form the length of their caterpillar. Some children may like to glue the circles onto a piece of paper to place the caterpillar on it.
- Add the legs by spreading the glue onto all the circles so as to attach the many legs that caterpillars have.
- You may also like to add two strips of paper for the caterpillars "antenna" on its head.
- Adding other details with felt markers, crayons, pencil or things like stamps or small bingo dabbers may also be nice to add some details.
- Try QTip painting on the caterpillar.
- Try some soft tiny pieces of cotton or bit of wool to make a fuzzy body....

Story: "The Very Hungry Caterpillar"

This can be in book form or a felt story.

If you have a felt story, this is great for children to participate by helping with the pieces of the story.

It is very interactive and inclusive of the children and other family members and adults.
