Project #726: Fish in an Aquarium!

- Cut out the Center of one paper plate.
- Place this one top of another paper plate to form a "Bubble Appearance"
- Staple together.
- Paint or colour the center of the bubble blue or turquoise to make this appear like water.
- Cut out various tiny fish such as little basic fish, starfish, octopus, sharks, eels and whales.
- Children may glue the fish onto the center of the Aquarium shape within the "Bubble area".
- Add some seaweed look by using strips of tissue paper. These can be brown, green and gold to appear like seaweed.
- Add some bits of cellophane or bubble paper to add some "Water and Wave look."

Activity: Pet store or Aquarium Visit

Visit the local Aquarium or pet store to view the various fish in the Aquariums. Look on the shelves of the pet store to see the various types of Aquarium containers and items that you would need for this.
