Project #728: "Bugs on a Log"!

- Provide a stalk of celery.
- Cut into short pieces about 4 inches long.
- Add some cream cheese or other creamy cheese to the Center of the Celery piece. This could also be peanut butter if there are no allergies to this.
- Provide some small currents or small raisins. These can be the "Bugs" for your log.
- Use a variety of fruits and vegetables for your creation!
- Place the raisins or currents onto the log to create your design.
- Try some other food ideas like small edible seeds could be used as well as the raisins and currents.
- Small nuts may also be another idea.
- Try some Whipping Cream on top of this. No need for sugar in the whipping cream.
- Have fun and eat!

Activity: Shop with your children to pick the celery and other items you choose for your project! Before eating your "Bugs on a Log", think about counting how many "Bugs" you have. Look at the colours of the items you chose to create your own Celery project!
