Project: 730: Fish Projects!

- Cut out two identical fish shapes from some thin paper.
- Staple them partially together leaving an opening at one end of the fish shapes.
- Draw any details such as eyes, gills, fins etc. onto the front and the back of the fish shapes. Use crayons or pencil crayons for this. Also Tissue paper is nice to glue onto the fish shape. Permanent markers could also be used.
- Stuff the fish with the remainder on the paper scraps.
- Staple the opening closed.
- You will now have a 3D fish shape.
- Painting this 3D fish would enhance the project too if you like.
- Bingo Dabbers could also be used to dab spots onto your fish.
- When your fish is dry attach a string to the end of the fish to hang it up.
- Tape onto the paper will secure the string in place. Using a hole puncher after the tape is a good way to secure the paper so it will be less likely to rip

Activity: Go to the beach when the tide is out!

Walk in the small warm puddles while the tide is out. You will see the small fish scurry about in these warm puddles. You may also see small crabs and shells.
