- Please provide various sizes of thin paper plates.
- Cut a triangle out of part of this paper plate for the Mouth of the Fish.
- Use the triangle piece to add to the end of the fish to create the fin at the back of your fish. Please secure this with some staples or strong glue or tape.
- Try cutting more parts from other paper or more paper plate pieces to create more fins and gills for your fish.
- You may like to add some details with some felt markers, crayons or pencil crayons.
- Try gluing some bubble paper onto the fish shape as this creates a nice texture for your fish.
- Add some sparkles if you like.
- Try some bingo dabbers as this will work well for the "Scales of the fish"
