Project #738: Beach Combing!

- Beach combining: Walk and dig through the sand to see what you may collect.
- Take a walk on the sand when the tide is out.
- Walk in the warm puddles of the ocean when the tide is out.
- Feel the little fish as they swim past your feet.
- Watch for the tiny and large crabs under the surface of the puddles.
- If there is some seaweed, pick it up and examine it. Be careful not to disturb the ocean life that may be in the seaweed. There could be small crabs for example.
- Please be aware that the crabs have “pinchers” that can “Bite” if the crab is disturbed! Especially be cautious of larger crabs.
- Be aware and gentle with the sea creatures.
- If you find some large rocks, you may find Starfish attached to them. They also could be attached to the poles of structures such as the piers at ocean sides.

Activity: Learn about sea life by reading books and observing photos. Watch that you know what to be cautious of as some “jelly fish” or other fish may be poisonous!
