Project #745: Fall Umbrella!

- Cut out the shape of various styles of an umbrella.
- Use various colours of construction paper for the umbrella.
- Use the scraps of paper to cut out various sizes of raindrops
- The children may like to draw the lines of the umbrella which are basic curves. You may like to draw the first one or two lines as a sample.
- Using a glue stick, glue the drops of rain onto the Umbrellas
- Add some nature to this as you may find some fall leaves or seeds that will be falling off some of the plants and flowers.
- Provide stickers if you like.
- Provide some stamps.
- Small bingo dabbers or QTip painting could also be used.
- Try some sparkles.
- Try some bubble paper as this can appear like rain drops as well.
- Try some cellophane paper as raindrops as this will have the appearance of water...

Activity: Nature Walk on a Dry Day and Rainy Day Walk!

Go on a Nature walk on a dry day and see what you can find to glue onto your umbrellas.

Go on a Rainy Day walk with real umbrellas.
