Project #746: Fall Apples!

- Provide apple shaped paper such as red, green or yellow construction paper.
- Add some tissue paper of various apple colours with glue. The tissue paper can be laid flat or scrunched for a 3D look.
- Another idea is to use sponges to dip into some paint to dab onto your apple shape.
- Add some paper leaves and a stem to your apple
- Try using Bingo Dabbers or some Qtip painting
- Make a large Apple and place it on an easel to paint with paint brushes of various sizes.
- Have children do a group project by making many apples to create a "Tree".
- Glue these onto a poster board and add paper branches and a tree trunk.
- Add some paper leaves or draw some leaves.

Activity: "Make Applesauce"

- Peel some firm crispy apples such as Macintosh or Granny Smith apples.
- Boil in a small amount of water in a large pot or saucepan.
- Keep them simmering slowly until they soften up.
- Knead them down squishing with a potato masher.
- Add some cinnamon for taste.
- Add sugar only if it is needed.
- Let cool and place in jars.
- Refrigerate after it is cool and in the jars with the lid closed.
- Canning can be done with canning jars as well.
