Project #747: Apple Orchard and Trees!

- Use a template or photo copy of an apple tree.
- Draw apples and leaves on this.
- Create your own apple tree by using various pieces of construction paper, one for the trunk, one for the top for the leaves and then add some red, yellow or green dots for apples.
- Try some apple shaped stickers.
- Add tissue paper to your apple shapes.
- Add some extra small leaves to accent the apples on the green top.
- If you would like to make a group project, have the family and friends make many trees and place them onto a poster board.
- Add people, animals and other nature items as you like.
- Try using some 3D items such as real stems from apples and some flattened apple leaves.
- What about the peel of the apple? Maybe it could be dried and placed on your creation with glue

Felt Story: "Farmer Brown"

Make a felt tree shape.

Cut out some felt apple shapes.

Place the felt apples on the felt apple tree.

Count them with the children.
