Project #743: Traffic Lights and Street Signs!

- Provide children with a Stop Sign Shape, Yield triangle, Walk and Don't walk signals and Traffic light shapes.
- Provide some circles which are Green for go, Yellow for slow down and Red for Stop.
- Place these circles in the proper order on your traffic light shape. Green at bottom, Yellow in the middle and Red at the top.
- Glue them in place.
- Sparkles may also be used on the circles to give them a "Light or Shiny Reflective look"
- For the Stop Sign and Yield Sign, print the letters on the shape.
- Add a stick to glue at the base of the shape.
- Try creating Walk and Don't walk with words as well as the symbols of walking or no walking.

Activity:

Talk about safety on roads and sidewalks. Look each way at least 3 times to be sure of traffic signals and the speed of the vehicles traveling. Watch for all the traffic lights and the Walk vs Don't walk signals. Be sure children are aware to always check the traffic as some vehicles make mistakes as well as some pedestrians also make mistakes. Watch out for Bicycles, scooters, skate boards, electric bikes, motor cycles plus more as vehicle types are increasing and changing! Go for a walk and practice safety!
