(Kids Care Preschool Activity)

## Project #748: All about me Hand Prints and Painting!

- Provide some liquid non-toxic paint in some recycle washable trays.
- Use the Primary Colours which are Red, Yellow and Blue
- Supple some construction paper or large poster boards.
- Children may place their hands or fingers in the paint.
- Place the painted hand or fingers onto the paper and press firmly so as to get the flattened print of your child's fingers or hand.
- Add some sparkles to this before it dries if you like.
- Make a Picture Frame from some more paper.
- Place this frame around the child's handprint.
- Use your leftover paint as finger paint.
- Notice how the colours blend and change. Red and Yellow make orange, Red and blue make purple and Blue and Yellow make green!
- If they continue to mix and swirl the colours, it will probably become brown!
- This may also be used to make a hand print within the paint. Let it dry.
- The swirls can also be formed into another drawing of what they like which could be swirls or other drawing that the child chooses to make!

<u>Science:</u> Have some coloured see through paddles to view and see how the colour changes when they are placed on top of each other. Using food colouring in see-through jars is another idea.
